



## COURSE GUIDELINES

- Complete registration form (obtained from your bishop) and mail – WITH TUITION - to IOCS, PO Box 771, Wells, ME 04090
- Go to [www.institute.toccusa.org](http://www.institute.toccusa.org) and register for access to lectures.
- Access to lectures will be activated when your tuition and registration form are received.
- Once your course has been activated, you may log onto the website to watch the lecture. You may also download the lecture script for further reference.
- Make sure you are part of a discussion group and are able to participate in group meetings or conference calls following each lecture. Participation in discussion group is **REQUIRED**.
- If you are absolutely unable to attend a discussion, then you **MUST** post your ~~file~~ to that lecture on the Forum.
